NJASAP CONGRATULATES FOXX ON CONFIRMATION

(COLUMBUS) – The NetJets Association of Shared Aircraft Pilots is pleased to congratulate Anthony R. Foxx on his confirmation to serve as the next U.S. Secretary of Transportation. The Senate Thursday unanimously approved the nomination made by President Obama in late April. Foxx, who has a long history of public service, most recently served as the mayor of Charlotte, N.C., the youngest person ever elected to the post.
